

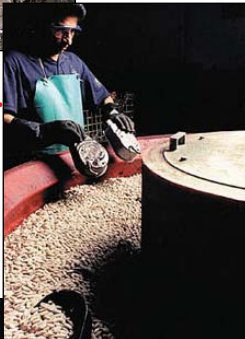
What is Remanufacturing?

The testing and procedures are the same as the original equipment manufacturers.
